#### **Advisory Visit**

We'll follow up our visit with an email containing suggested reading and further research, and relevant learning resources or advice sheets that we discussed at the visit.

#### Advisory Visit +

The 3-stage Advisory Visit + offers excellent value for money. We begin the process with a short self-assessment audit, which we email to you beforehand. The audit includes questions about the character of your grounds, how they are used and by whom, and how they are cared for. We ask you to complete the audit and return it to us before we visit you - by analysing your responses, we can start thinking about where your development priorities might lie.

As with a standard Advisory Visit, we'll tour your outdoor spaces, explore the role they play in the setting's everyday life and observe children outdoors. Together we'll review your selfassessment audit and your school improvement plan. If possible, we'll examine your medium term curriculum themes. This helps us build a mosaic of realistic options for improvement outdoors, based on what's needed and will have an impact. Making use of your expert understanding of your school and its community, we'll work together to identify key areas for change, whether your motivation is making changes to the way you use or manage outdoors, or making physical improvements to the space.

Afterwards, we'll send you an illustrated report summarising current use, resourcing and practice; the key points we discussed at the visit; recommendations for change and suggested reading / research. This report could form the basis for an action plan for improvements that will have a positive impact on children's experiences at your school.
